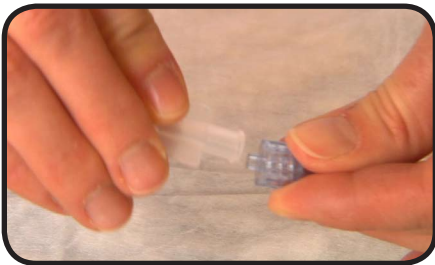
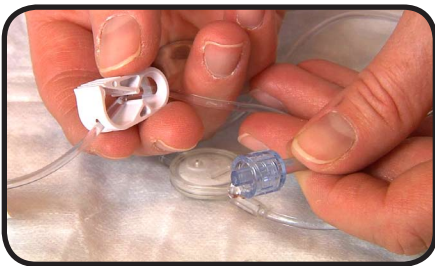


Medication Balls

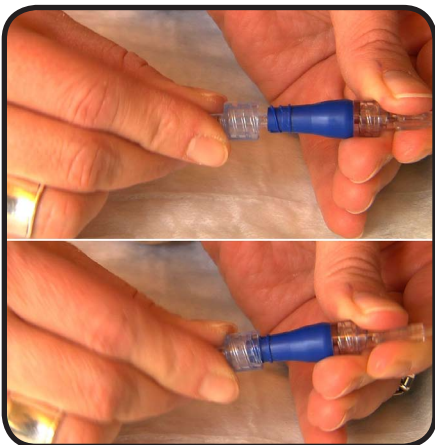
After flushing your catheter or IV line with a pre-filled saline syringe . . . (see attached sheet for flushing instructions)



1. Remove the clear protective cap by twisting and pulling it off from the end of the med-ball tubing. Make sure to protect end of tubing from contamination (keep sterile).



2. Release the clamp on the tubing and watch for a few drops to form, then re-clamp.



3. Attach the end of the med-ball tubing to your IV line hub, push in, and turn clockwise.



4. Unclamp the tubing and your infusion will begin (make sure all clamps on the PICC line are open).

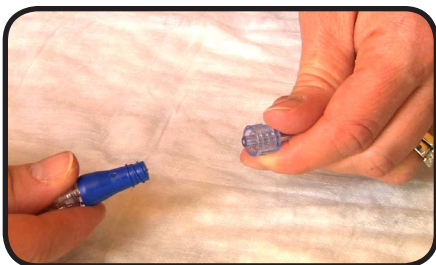

5. You can place the med-ball in a pocket or purse and go about your activities. Check the ball after about 10 minutes to make sure it is infusing. It should feel softer now, like a tomato.



6. After the prescribed amount of time, check the med-ball again. When your entire dose has infused, the ball should look deflated and wrinkled around an inner core.



7. Un-hook the med-ball tubing from your cap after prescribed time has elapsed. Then perform post flushing procedure.
